

# 2 DRY RAINFOREST (hinterland)

## NOT CURRENTLY LISTED

**Habitat:** moderate to low elevation where limited to stony ground and scree associated with escarpments, steep slopes, river escarpments and ridges.

**Localities**

**Port Macquarie:** Wayne Richards Oval hillside;

**North Shore:** steep stoney hillsides and skeletal soils on serpentinite at North Shore (Crown Land Quarry);

**West of Lake Innes to the Pacific Highway:** between Apanie and Ryans Rd

**NOTE:** species lists are likely to vary according to locality and individual stands. Local species lists to the site in question have precedence over the generalised list provided here. Lists do not include sites west of Pacific Highway (Bago Bluff, Yarras etc.)
