SWAMP OAK FOREST (brackish version)

Habitat: brackish reaches of low gradient creeks, around coastal embayments, the lower lying river flats of the estuarine reaches of rivers, creeks and drainage lines. Often the first EC inland from the saline version of this EC and downstream of Swamp Sclerophyll Forest where the saline influence diminishes.

Localities: floodplains, creeks and gullies of the coastal plains and brackish areas associated with Queens Lake, Laurieton, Dunbogan, North Haven, Lake Cathie, Lake Innes, Port Macquarie, Kooloobung Creek, Limbeburners Creek (to name a few), and the estuarine reaches of the lower Camden Haven, Hastings, Wilson River and Maria rivers.
